## IMPORTANT AND URGENT! UPDATE OF THE IPPK APPLICATION LOG-IN PROCEDURE AND TERMS OF USE

Dear Sir/Madam,

we have introduced a second alternative method of obtaining a code in the two-factor authentication process to secure the log-in to the iPPK application.

After the change, the code is obtainable in two ways:

- **by means of an authentication application**, which can be downloaded and installed free of charge on your smartphone or tablet (e.g. Duo, Google Authenticator or Microsoft Authenticator), or
- in a text message (SMS), which will be sent to the phone number assigned to the user in the iPPK application (Check whether all iPPK application users in your organisation have been assigned a phone number to which we can send a text message).

**Remember that two-factor authentication increases data security.** Find out how easy it is and **enable** additional protection!

## Following changes to the two-factor authentication functionality, we have updated:

- the procedure for data exchange through the iPPK application, which is available <u>here</u>
- o the terms of use of the iPPK application, which are available here

The new functionality will be available from 7.05.2024 (date of entry into force of the updated documents).



**Important!** On 18 September 2024, two-factor authentication will be enabled by default on all iPPK application user accounts.
