# HOW TO GAIN ACCESS TO YOUR PPK OR PPE?

Would you like to have access to your PPK or PPE and transaction history? Are you wondering if all contributions to your pension capital are paid in a timely manner? Do you want to know if the welcome payment, annual bonus and all payments from the employer have been transferred to your PPK account?

You can preview the PPK and PPE register in IKO and iPKO even without having a bank account with PKO Bank Polski S.A. — all you need is to submit an electronic **Application for access to IKO or iPKO without an account.** 

## The IKO app and iPKO electronic banking

- 1. You can download the IKO app to your phone from your device's app store. Type in "IKO" or "PKO" and search for the IKO app.
- 2. You can also track the current PPK or PPE balance and the transaction history in iPKO the electronic banking service of PKO Bank Polski S.A. (www.pkobp.pl).





### The i-Fundusze website

The PKO TFI i-Fundusze website provides the most extensive access to information about the PPK or PPE account and the option to place selected orders.

You can access the website at www.pkotfi.pl by clicking on the **Log in to i-Fundusze** or **Log in to PPK** button in the top right corner of the page. Then click **First logging Individual**.



## i-Fundusze service – first logon

Prepare the Identifier. This is the 8-digit Participant Number that you will find in the correspondence received from us. It is also part of the register number; in the example sequence 08-XXXXXXXX-997-01, it comes after 08. Image showing the Participant Number.

**NOTE!** TI order to complete your first logon, make sure that your data is valid. If you are unsure whether your data recorded in the participant register is valid, please contact our helpline. During the conversation, check the scope and validity of the data.

If we do not have your mobile phone number, but we have your Personal ID number (PESEL):

## IT WILL BE NECESSARY TO ORDER A PIN

After additional verification of data at https://i-fundusze.pl/firstLogin/individual, you will order a PIN for your first logon. The order to send a PIN will be confirmed with a text message. We will send you the PIN by post to your correspondence address that we have in the system. Wait for the letter to arrive. The average waiting time for the letter can range from a few days to 2 weeks.

Only after receiving the letter with the PIN, go to https://i-fundusze.pl/

Enter the 8-digit Participant Number in the Identifier field and enter the PIN you received in the Password field. Then, after logging in to the system, set your own login Password. After replacing the PIN with the login Password, log in with the set Password. Keep the PIN – it can be used for your authorisation via the helpline in the future.



If we have your mobile phone number and Personal ID number (PESEL):

After additional verification of data at https://i-fundusze.pl/firstLogin/individual, you will be able to set your system Password.

Then, go to https://i-fundusze.pl/ and log in to the system.

If we do not have your e-mail address, you will be asked to provide one after logging in to the system. Therefore, if your access to i-Fundusze is blocked, you can use the "I forgot the password" function.



If we have your mobile phone number and e-mail address:

We will send a message to the e-mail address you have indicated, containing a link which you can use to set the Participant's system password. Follow the Instructions.

After setting the Password, go to https://i-fundusze.pl/ and log in to the system.

## As a PPK participant, you can use the i-Fundusze website to, among others:

- · Monitor the status of the PPK register
- Change sub-funds within the PPK (place orders to change the distribution of payments and funds)
- Withdraw funds from the PPK (place orders for disbursement after reaching the age of 60 or refund before reaching that age)
- · Add or change beneficiaries
- Use the broad product range of PKO TFI, including products dedicated to PPK and PPE participants (on preferential terms)
- · Receive documentation related to the PPK by e-mail

As a PPE participant, you can use the i-Fundusze website to monitor the status of the PPE register, while PPE-related orders you can handle only through the employer.
